

Strategies Applied:

This is a perfect pantry or freezer clean out project. Because nut prices are so great in December and January, I often buy large amounts for the year and put them in my freezer. I pulled several varieties out from the previous year to make these crackers.

- It's really worth while to look at alternatives to your grocery – I often buy at Aldi's or our Mill's Fleet Farm – which is a farm supply store with all sorts of products – everything from saddles to outdoor furniture.
- Sometimes the drug stores (Walgreen, CVS, etc.) have good prices.
- If you have a “nut supply” house in your area, their prices can't be beat.
- In the regular grocery store, check the baking aisle, the snack aisle and the bulk aisle - and check for coupons, too, on some nuts.
- I also stock up around Christmas and freeze my nuts.
